Lighted fixtures and provocative objects are rich in imagery from Patti's fertile and observant mind. She's a great storyteller in both words and images.



One of the show highlights is the Star of David window from a 19th-century East Village synagogue, Congregation Beth Hagodol Anshe Ungarn. Patti meticulously restored the Star over a period of several years.

Patti worked with many of the foremost artists in the field



for twenty years restoring such landmarks as the Grand Central Station clock before she opened her studio in 1993 doing original work, commissions, restorations and 8-week courses in stained glass for beginner to expert level students.
